3rd Neighborhood Meeting for the 4th Street Reconstruction Project

The purpose of this meeting will be to present the final design drawings to the neighborhood and to gather public input. The final design drawings have been completed in accordance to the findings of the feasibility study and input received from residents at previous neighborhood meetings. Staff will have more information on the following topics at the meeting:

- Final design selections and project components
- Water and sanitary service line assessments
- Tree removal and trimming
- Electric line undergrounding

This meeting is your chance to express your views on the final design before it is presented for the council for approval. A short presentation will occur at 6:00 PM with the remainder of the time used as an open house format. During the open house you will have the opportunity to review, comment, and obtain more detailed information about the project.

Public input gathered at this meeting will be presented to the council as they consider approval of the plans and specifications at the March 16, 2010 council meeting. Approval of the plans will trigger the staff to advertise for bids. Significant changes to the plans are not anticipated after council approval.

The Neighborhood Meeting will be conducted by the City's engineering consulting firm, Bolten & Menk Inc.
