Updated Press Release Business Burglary Suspects Identified July 12th, 2018

Updated information related to the Tobacco Field Burglary previously reported on July 10th, 2018:

With assistance from the community, Northfield Police Department Investigators identified and interviewed two juvenile suspects in the burglaries. Investigators completed search warrants at three locations and recovered property and merchandise allegedly stolen in the burglaries at Tobacco Field. Police expect the two juvenile suspects to be charged at a later date.

The Northfield Police Department would like to thank persons who reached out with information to assist with the investigation.

There have been several other burglaries of Northfield businesses in the last three weeks. The Northfield Police Department reminds all community members, but especially business owners and employees to follow these guidelines related to business security:

- Ensure All doors, windows, and other access points are properly locked or secured after business hours.
- Evaluate and update lock systems to make sure access points are not easily breached.
- If your business does not have a video surveillance or alarm system, consider installing one or both. If you have such systems, check them regularly to make sure they are working properly.
- Evaluate how your business secures cash, sensitive data, and/or valuable property after hours.
- Educate all employees regarding the security expectations of your business and the above listed suggestions.
